

Fall Color Report

18 Nov. 2021

There is still fall color to be seen in our woods and collections. The last of the understory sugar maples and oaks in our woodlands and collections near P8 and between P10 and P15 show the best color. Still colors on isolated plants near P16 and P17 in our Appalachia and China collections. On the west side, witch-hazels, larch, and bald-cypress near Lake Marmo show late color as do the prairie grasses.

Last chance for nature's fall colors before the lights of Illumination shine bright!
