about and this need

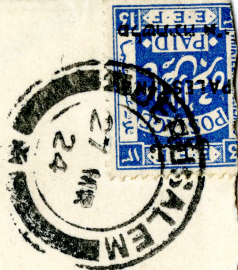
not interfere with Mr
