Dear Mr. Dow:

Last fall Mrs. Cudahy decided to do some beautification work along the highway right of way on Route 53. This planting was done under the name of the Lake Forest Garden Club, but Mrs. Cudahy paid for all the materials used. In other words the Morton Arboretum bought the material and planted it, and she then reimbursed us. The amount she paid was \$101.50, and this was to offset a bill of a corresponding amount which we paid to Onarga Nursery Company, Onarga, Illinois.
